

Several congregants have received emails from someone claiming to be Wilma+ in need of iTunes cards or other financial help for herself or a friend.


These are all SCAMS. DO NOT REPLY. DELETE.

Someone is setting up fake emails with Wilma's name, pictures of her from websites, and has hacked into her address book. Do not reply to any emails from [variations of Wilma's name]@gmail.com. Delete and report them to Google. It may be tempting to reply because you feel special or honored that she reached out to you for help, but thanks be to God, Wilma does not need help for herself or a friend. You have helped her already by giving her a rest from church responsibilities, time to be refreshed, and time to connect with loved ones around the world. So that she may continue to enjoy her sabbatical, we ask that you please not reach out to her about this. Instead, if you have any questions or concerns, please contact Donna or Sarah+.

Wilma is on her 30-day silent retreat. Please keep Wilma in your prayers. Wilma should not be contacted. As usual, contact the office for any pastoral needs. We know how to contact her in emergency situations. She is off the grid and not emailing anyone. Please see above box.
